

PERMETHRIN IMPREGNATION PACK



For added protection against insects e.g. Mosquitoes, Sandflies and Ticks that can carry diseases such as Malaria, Dengue, Ross River Virus, Japanese B Encephalitis and Tick Borne Encephalitis.

WHAT IS PERMETHRIN?

Permethrin is a synthetic pyrethroid contact insecticide that kills mosquitoes and other insects. The natural pyrethrum insecticide protects flowers such as the Chrysanthemum from insect attack.



HOW DOES IT WORK?

Pyrethroids work by quickly paralyzing the nervous system of insects after it comes in contact with the substance or if the insect ingests it. The Permethrin is effective against all stages of insect growth particularly larvae.

IS IT SAFE?

It is not classified as hazardous according to criteria of Worksafe Australia. It is safe for use on babies and children's clothing. It has a very low acute toxicity and studies have found side effects from absorbed permethrin are very rare.

GENERAL INFORMATION:



Permethrin adheres to the fabric and is effective for approximately six months. It will survive several (6-10) washing in hot or cold water. Once treated, netting or clothing has no vapour or odour.

IMPORTANT PRODUCT INFORMATION:

This is not an insect repellent and should not be applied to the skin. The permethrin does not adhere to the skin the same way that it bonds with fabrics.

DIRECTIONS:

Garment to be treated should be soaked in the prepared solution for at least two minutes. Lay or hang to dry in a well-ventilated area. Full directions are enclosed in the Impregnation pack.

CAUTION:

Dangerous to fish. Do not contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with chemical or used container. Do not dispose of unused solution in storm water drains or sewers.



HINTS:



Place remaining diluted solution into a spray pack and spray onto your hat, backpack, tops of shoes etc.

Don't forget to soak your mosquito net if it isn't already impregnated.

To prolong the life of your impregnated clothing/mosquito net, store in a sealed plastic bag.

You can dispose of excess diluted solution in your garden, as it is great for ant control!
